

When I arrived in
Parkersburg, I was almost immediately invited to join up with a group called the Ministerial Alliance. Clergy from across Wood County would gather and support each other. Often, I was the only female present. I felt fully accepted and part of everything, but I missed the clergywomen groups that I had experienced in previous calls. I knew there were a lot of female pastors in the area; I just didn't know how

Last summer, I connected with some local female clergy. We formed a group on Facebook and started meeting every few

to connect with them.

months to connect and support each other in ministry. Sometimes we would do something together, like make candles or prayer beads. Other times we meet for lunch to talk about how ministry is going and what's going on in the area. We support each other, hear each other's stories, and pray together.

Out of this, I learned about a group of churches who had

started working together to feed the community on weekends. There are a lot of places to get a meal during the week. But on weekends, it could be a bit more difficult. The Gathering on 14th Street serves a meal on Saturdays. Sundays were then divided among the other churches participating. Christ United Methodist serves on the First Sunday of the month, the local Methodist churches work together to serve on the second Sunday of the month, St. Paul's United Methodist serves on the third Sunday of the month, and Hope Mission and Good Shepherd serve on the last Sunday of the month. This means

that there was a vacancy about once per quarter: on the fourth Sunday of the month when there were five Sundays. After talking to the

Mission Committee and the group of churches that make up the Community Meal Initiative, I volunteered our church to host once per quarter on the fourth Sunday when there are five Sundays in the month. Thank you to everyone who made the meal a success on March 24th. We had a great time and got to feed a number of people from the

community. We also gave out underwear, socks, and hats to many who needed them. Thank you to everyone who brought food, prepared the meal, set-up, served, and cleaned up.

O'm really excited about this ministry. I love working with other churches to do ministry and to have fellowship. Last year, I also connected with the other Presbyterian pastors in the area and we had our first cluster events! We hosted the choir from Geneva College, with multiple churches helping and us hosting the beautiful concert. We did a pulpit swap in July. And this month, we have another opportunity to come

together as well! On April 21 we are meeting up for a 3:00 p.m. cruise on the Valley Gem and a delicious potluck meal.

We are part of the body of Christ. And as Presbyterians, we believe in being connected. That means that we can participate in



ministry together, and fellowship together, all that we might glorify Christ and connect as brothers and sisters in Christ. To God be the Glory!


SATURDAY STEWARDS


